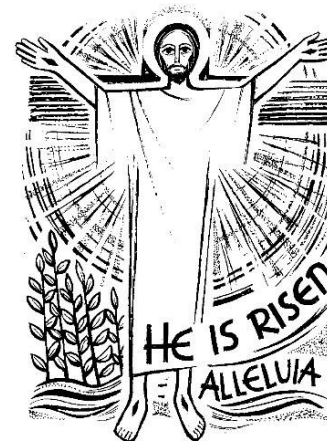

As announced by our president we are allowed to have **250 people in the Church and 200 people in Emmaus Centre** gathering for Mass in our parish. However, bookings are still required to attend the Saturday 6.00pm Mass and the Sunday 7.30am and 10.00am Masses. The first 250 people arriving for Mass will be accommodated in the Church, thereafter the next 200 people will be in the Emmaus Centre. The Mass will be streamed from the Church to the Emmaus Centre. All protocols must be adhered to.
